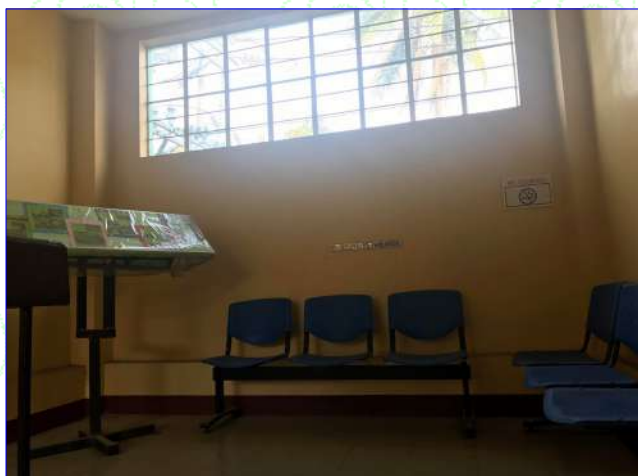
A lot of new things happened in the library ...

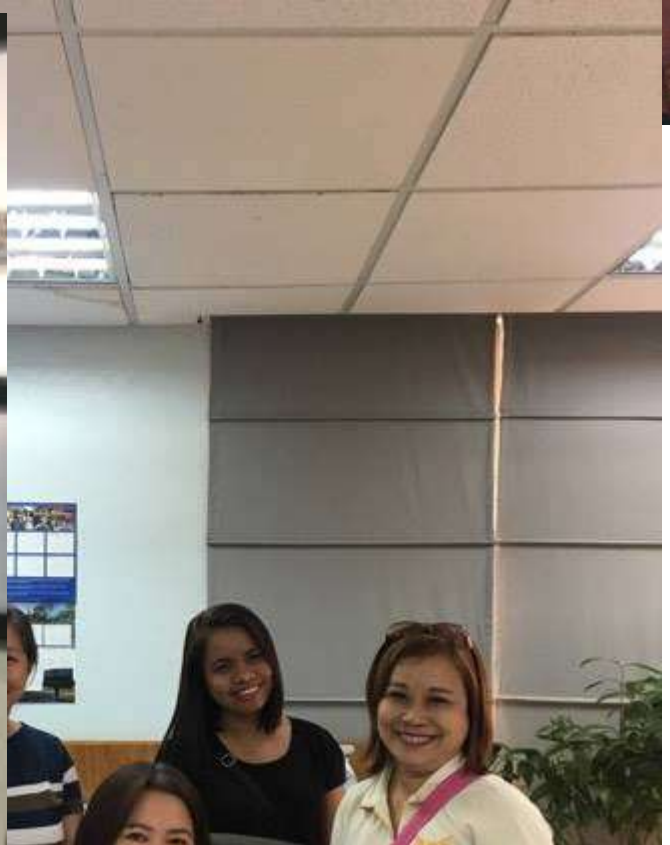
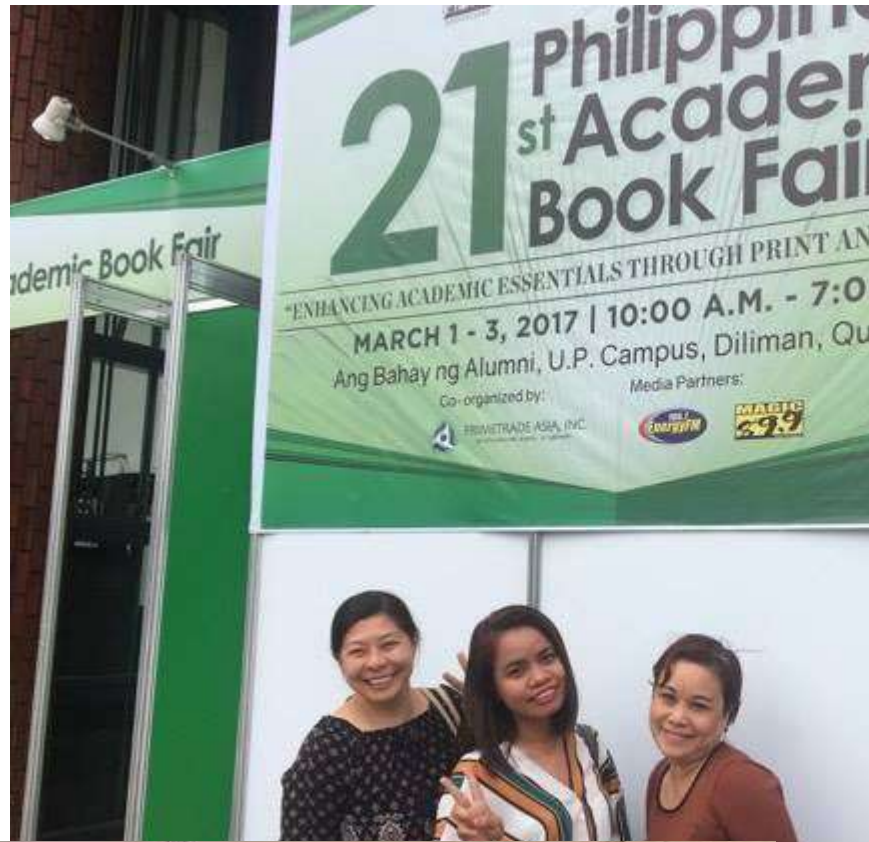


EARIST held its founding anniversary
